



Friday, November 08 Arrive in Juba (SOUTH SUDAN)



From Asmara, Eritrea, take a mid-day flight to **Juba** via Addis Ababa. Upon arrival in the late afternoon, meet the local representative and transfer to *Royal Palace Hotel or similar* for check-in and overnight.

Saturday, November 09 Juba (Mundari Cattle Camp)



After breakfast, begin the drive to **Terekeka Town** to visit the **Mundari** for an up-close look into their culture and a chance to understand their way of life. The Mundari are a small group of cattle-herders and agriculturalists and for them, cattle are a form of currency and status. The men of this tribe often wash their hair in cow urine to give it a yellowish-orange hue and wear ritual scars on their foreheads. Enjoy a picnic lunch and later, watch the cows return to camp at sunset, an unforgettable site. Return to the *Hotel* in Juba for overnight. **(B,L)**

Wednesday, November 10 Juba - USA



After an early breakfast, have a quick tour of the city to the major points of interest as time permits including **Jubek Mausoleum** and **Juba Maasai Market**, an open market to shop for hand-crafted items, jewelry, fabrics, paintings, soap stone carvings, and wooden statues. Also visit the **Baobab House/Gallery**, named after the Baobab Tree, which is generally referred to as the "Tree of Life". The **All-Saints Cathedral**, built in 1959, holds daily services in Arabic, English, and Zande. Then, transfer to the airport for your flight back to the US. **(B)**

- Alien certificate done within 72 hours of arrival in South Sudan (currently \$65.00 – to be paid in cash).
- Beverages or drinks with or without meals and lunches & dinners while in Juba.
- Items of a personal nature (camera fees, laundry, excess luggage, etc.).
- Dayroom/overnights necessitated by changes in airline schedules or misconnections.
